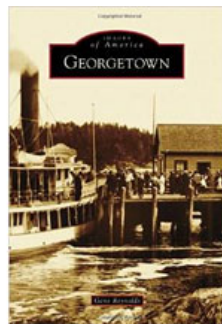
July 29
